### HOW THE CAMP CARD SALE WORKS

The Camp Card sale is a **risk-free** fundraiser designed to assist Scout units and families in fundraising for their summer activities, while reducing out of pocket costs. Each camp card contains over \$300 in coupons which the Scouts sell for \$10 while earning a 50% commission!

- There is no upfront cost.
- Units check out cards without payment or deposit. The number of cards distributed will be based on past year's camp cards sales.
- Any undamaged, unsold cards can be returned on or before March 24<sup>th</sup> for redistribution.
- Additional cards can be checked out when payment is made for the first set of cards. This ensures that no individual or unit has too many unsold cards and allows units to secure additional cards as needed.

### IMPORTANT DATES & DEADLINES

**January 16th-** Sign up for the Sale!

**March 3rd:** Camp Card Kickoff

**March 3<sup>rd</sup>** Camp Card Distribution

**March 4<sup>th</sup>-** Sale Begins

**March 24<sup>th</sup>:** Mid Sale Return – Sale not going well – turn in unsold cards for redistribution

**April 10th** Sale Ends; Payment Due and unsold cards returned

**April 14<sup>th</sup> - DEADLINE FOR PAYMENT & CARD RETURN (Cards not returned may be charged)**

## STORE FRONTS

Many Scouts sell camp cards in front of our community businesses in addition to door-to-door sales. It is the Unit/Scout's responsibility to check with store management to arrange sales. We advise that you speak to your local businesses, venues, churches, and other supporting organizations in your community about the possibility of supporting Scout fundraisers.

**Remember – no storefront sales in front of Rosauers or Super 1 Foods!**

## BSA FUNDRAISER SELLING GUIDELINES

- Camp Cards, Product Sales, and Popcorn sales are the only council approved fundraisers and do not require the submission of the Money Earning Application.
- Direct solicitation by leaders or youth members of cash donations from community business, individuals, service organizations, etc., are not allowed! Units raise their needed funds through approved product sales and fundraising events, payments from members dues, and family support.
- Revenue from sales can be returned to Inland Northwest Council at any time throughout the campaign. For each card sold, units keep \$5 and are responsible for returning the remaining \$5 in revenue to the council.

## RETURN POLICY

The cards **MUST** be in new condition (including snap off discounts). The Camp Card Support Team reserves the right to refuse product that has been damaged or rendered unsaleable. The unit is responsible for any unreturned cards (lost, misplaced, damaged, etc.). **Be sure Scouts and parents treat each card as if it were a \$10 bill.**
