



Cubmaster Guide to WEBELOS Transition to Scouts BSA

1. What does "WEBELOS" stand for? "WE'll BE LOyal Scouts".
 - WEBELOS scouts are Cub Scouts preparing for graduation into Scouts BSA which includes: outdoor activities, working as a patrol, and becoming a leader.
2. WEBELOS Den activities also include:
 - Patrol name, cheer, and flag
 - Help lead pack meetings.
 - Learn while having FUN!
 - Attend resident camp.
 - Plan crossover by March or April
 - Completing 5 required Adventures and one elective
 - Parents completing Youth Protection and Cyber Chip award
 - ARROW OF LIGHT requirements should also be discussed with your den leaders.
3. Contact several Scouts BSA Troops in your area.
4. Visit several troops and attend their WEBELOS FUN DAYS
5. Attend campouts with a troop.
